# Signs & Symbols From Spirit

I always describe communicating with Spirit almost like a game of charades. As I grow in my mediumship, my list of signs and symbols from Spirit grows as well.

Over time I have accumulated hundreds of signs from Spirit! Just like in the game of charades, we know that tugging on the ear means "sounds like" or imitating the cranking of a camera means "movie", or holding up three fingers means "three words"

Just like the signs we mime and have grown to know from playing charades, I have grown my own list of signs and symbols from Spirit.

#### For example:

Spirit tapping on the nose means "we look alike" Hand over the heart means "I love you" Pointing at the eyes means "glasses" Flexing your arms means "Strong"

There are lots of different signs and symbols and I built this by writing down the messages I was given and how the Spirits gave me that sign. Your signs will be different from other mediums because Spirits know how to send you signs based on your own intellect and life experiences. They show you things that you relate to! For example, I recently had a Spirit who spoke about music and wanted me to mention the artist Prince. The way they did that was by showing me my friend Terry, who is a HUGE Prince fan! See, Spirit using my friend Terry as a sign to me wouldn't make much sense to you.

By establishing a list of the signs and symbols you receive from spirit, it makes your readings easier and stronger.

➢ Buy yourself a beautiful journal!
